Cards for each round must not be shot after the last day for shooting for that round

Shot cards must be received by the scorer by or on the Wednesday 9 days after the end of the match period at the latest. Failure to ensure this may result in such cards being disqualified. **PLEASE do NOT send cards "to be signed for"**.

Stickers must be checked upon receipt and any errors reported immediately.

The issued stickers must be affixed to the front of each card (including 10m air rifle Air2 targets) by a club official (or by a club member in the presence of a club official) before the card is shot.

We **strongly** advise that all stickers are applied at the start of the season as stickers that might be lost or damaged cannot be replaced after the end of Round 1. We also advise that stickers are not just handed to the competitors to deal with themselves but that club officials, or officials and members as above, affix all the stickers and issue complete sets of cards to the competitors.

If two stickers are issued and one target card is used BOTH stickers must be on the card – if only one sticker is there only 10 shots will count!!

The stickers are marked **Team** or **IND** - please ensure that the correct stickers are on the cards (i.e. avoid having two team stickers on the same card). If IND or TEAM is not printed on the sticker, then it is an IND sticker.

Remember **NO STICKER = NO SCORE**, no exceptions!! (C&NTSA Rule 0.3)

Team & Individual cards may be shot concurrently; if you want to do this you must advise the scorer with your Round 1 cards and **BOTH sets of stickers must be on the cards adjacent to each other.**

All Leagues have ten rounds. In Individual leagues, points are allocated to each competitor in the order of all the total scores for the round. For team leagues, refer to the League Matrix tables shown on our website* to see every team's opponents in each round. Note that some team divisions might include rounds shot against a team's own declared average ('Average') and some may be shot against 'BYE'. Any 'Bye' rounds must be shot to gain the 2 points for a win.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: -

C&NTSA Rule 0.10: Cards for ALL competitions MUST be folded or trimmed to approximately A4 size to fit into a standard C4 envelope or similar to permit delivery via a household letter box. Do NOT cut off or fold at any shot holes!

C&NTSA Rule 0.11: Cards sent in underpaid or oversized packages may or may not be accepted by the scorer at their discretion. Any exceptional circumstances will be taken into consideration. For more detail please refer to Paras 1 & 2 of the Guidelines and Recommendations section in C&NTSA Rules which are on our website*.

C&NTSA Rule 0.12: New rule concerning use of Electronic Targets and Systems. These may be used only in the prone and deliberate 10m air competitions.

If cards are trimmed for posting then any printed trim line MUST remain on the card in full (Penalty 7.4.5.1 = disqualification).

If you have a valid reason to be late, contact the SCORER immediately and ask if they will agree.

All queries regarding scores must be sent directly to the scorer, either by Email or in writing, within 14 days of the issue date on the results sheet.

Results and averages (in Excel files) will be sent out by Email only and added to the 'League Results' page on our website* for the relevant season in both Excel and PDF format.
