As you may be aware, the club is currently negotiating a new lease with Bury Council. We have been offered lease for 21 years, as of April 2019. This not only gives the club security of a long term home, but also allows us to make financial commitments to make improvements to the club.

As the lease on offer is longer than 7 years, there is a requirement for the club to register the new lease with the Land Registry. Due to this requirement, the lease is currently in its draft form and currently under discussion with the committee and trustees, however we are confident that it won't be long before this is completed and the new lease is in place.
