MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS!

The subscriptions for 2024 are now overdue. Emails and messages have been sent out to all members explaining the rise in subscription rates and requesting that outstanding balances be settled. The club would like to remind members that if subscriptions are not settled, either in full or quarterly, by the end of December 2023, then it may be taken as a resignation of membership and their membership may be terminated. This will result in the police being informed and certificate holders may be contacted.

REMINDER OF CLUB OPENING TIMES!

*The closing times are dependent on the number of members shooting.

It has been noticed that members are turning up earlier and earlier, and this is forcing range officers to turn up earlier, which in turn creates a longer night and puts extra pressure on the range officers. Can members please note the opening times are listed above which we are asking members to observe. Turning up early does not mean early entry or early shooting.

It was also suggested that members who have key access who turn up early, should act as range officer and ensure all the opening arrangements are made, this would also mean that they are unable to shoot.

Historically, the official opening/start time was 7:30pm, which may be brought back should members continue insisting on arriving early, sometimes up to 45 minutes early before the official opening times. This also includes Wednesdays; we have members arriving at 6pm. Wednesdays were moved from 7pm to 6:30pm to try and combat this problem, but now members insist on arriving even earlier.

Fridays continue to remain less busy, but remember that as well as Wednesdays, airguns can also be shot on a Monday or Friday after the .22 has completed. We do however, permit air rifles to be shot at the same time as .22 rimfire as long as it is benchrest and **single shot (not magazine fed – anyone found shooting with a magazine fed rifle may be asked to leave the range)** – but air pistols cannot be shot at the same time as the .22 rimfire, these must wait until all .22 rimfire shooting has completed.

LEGAL MATTERS!

I have been made aware that a past member, who does not hold a firearm certificate, has been investigated for either having access to a firearm or holding live ammunition outside of the club. Can I please remind all members that possession of a single live round outside of the club without a valid firearm certificate will result in prosecution and potentially a conviction potentially resulting in a prison sentence. ALL non-certificate holders MUST return unspent rounds back into the possession of the range officer at the end of each night. Anyone wanting to remove a single empty shell casing MUST request the approval of the range officer before removing one from the club.

LEASE!

The renewal of the lease is moving forward and is currently back the council. We have been assured that all amendment requested have been considered, and we have requested a draft copy for approval. Further updates will be made when we have more information.
