WEDNESDAY NIGHTS!

It has been brought to the committees' attention that Wednesday nights have become so relaxed that it is now starting to raise concerns. It has been mentioned that the range etiquette, compared to Mondays and Fridays is so relaxed that is now seems to be more of a "free for all & anything goes".

I would like to remind members who regularly attend on a Wednesday about the following and also point out some new procedures:

- 1) As well as practice cards, we have members shooting competition cards. Therefore, members should refrain from talking on the range whilst others are still shooting. If you feel the need to talk, then please wait until you are back in the club room.
- 2) Standing at the door and talking over to somebody on a firing point is not permitted, this disturbs those shooting.
- 3) Once targets have been placed and members are shooting, under no circumstance is anyone to enter or leave the range. This, again is disturbing those who are currently shooting. Like a Monday or Friday, the range door is to remain closed whilst shooting takes place.
- 4) Mobiles phones are to be put onto silent mode or left in the club room. Please do not answer your phone on the range whilst others are shooting.
- 5) Please do not start to set up equipment on a firing point if others are shooting, again this is disturbing to them.
- 6) With immediate effect (as of Wednesday 13th March), the range booking system, just like on a Monday or Friday is to be used. Members must book their lane, place their targets, shoot them and then vacate. 1 rifle target may be placed, or 2 pistol targets. If you have more than 2 pistol targets to shoot then you must do so over 2 details.
- 7) Just like a Monday or Friday, you should not pre-book lanes this is not fair to others who may be waiting.
- 8) All airguns should be removed from the range once you have completed your detail. Other equipment may remain on the range, but placed against the back wall so that the lanes are free for other members.
- 9) Again, like Mondays and Friday, unless already pre-arranged with another range officer, the range officer of the night should not be shooting, they are solely responsible for the conduct of those using the club room and the range.

Also, I've been asked to make a polite reminder about a post/email from not long back, we now have two smoke alarms in place, one in the club room and one in the range above the firing points, therefore, like many other establishments, as well as smoking, vaping is now no longer permitted on the premises.

We ask that all members who attend on a Wednesday observe the above with immediate effect, but should you have any questions, please don't hesitate to get in touch.

REMINDER OF CLUB OPENING TIMES!

It has been noticed that members are turning up earlier and earlier, and this is forcing range officers to turn up earlier, which in turn creates a longer night and puts extra pressure on the range officers. Can members please note the opening times are listed above which we are asking members to observe. Turning up early does not mean early entry or early shooting.

Historically, the official opening/start time was 7:30pm, which may be brought back should members continue insisting on arriving early, sometimes up to 45 minutes early before the official opening times. This also includes Wednesdays; we have members arriving at 6pm. Wednesdays were moved from 7pm to 6:30pm to try and combat this problem, but members are still insisting on arriving earlier and earlier.

It is also requested that should a member, who have key access, turn up early, they should act as range officer until the rota'd person arrives. This includes setting up the club and facilities ready for others to arrive.

Fridays continue to remain less busy, but remember that as well as Wednesdays, airguns can also be shot on a Monday or Friday after the .22 has completed. We do however, permit air rifles to be shot at the same time as .22 rimfire as long as it is benchrest and **single shot (not magazine fed – anyone found shooting with a magazine fed rifle may be asked to leave the range)** – but air pistols cannot be shot at the same time as the .22 rimfire, these must wait until all .22 rimfire shooting has completed.
